Standards

- A set of child safe standards that workers must adhere to

Information sharing

- Prioritising child safety

Reportable Conduct Scheme

- Inappropriate behaviour must be reported

Independent Regulator

- Oversight of child safety in organisations

DPFEM will continue to:

- Prevent harm to children
- Recognise the signs of someone harming a child
- Respond quickly and appropriately if there is a suspicion of harm to a child
- Create a culture, systems, processes, practises and environments that support the safety and wellbeing of children and young people.
